The goal of sustainable development within the tourism industry remains a priority in the policy agenda of intergovernmental organisations and national agencies, as reflected by the United Nations' 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. The Agenda outlines a number of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) that reflect the United Nations' vision for inclusive social and economic development, environmental sustainability, security, good governance and equality amongst others. The SDGs provide guidance for tourism development and practice and enable the industry to contribute to the achievement of the 2030 Agenda. In light of the revised SDGs offered in the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, this edited book aims to revisit the concept of sustainability in tourism, hospitality and events and, through a collection of chapters, shed light on the economic, social, environmental and political dimensions of sustainability that carry positive and negative implications for global, regional and local tourism.

We invite you to submit your chapter proposals in the form of abstracts of up to 500 words on the following topics, but not limited to:

- Governance, effective institutions and sustainability in tourism, hospitality and events
- Sustainability in tourism and political economy
- Sustainability and cultural preservation in destinations
- Sustainability and local community wellbeing
- The ethicality of tourism and responsible consumption and production
- Sustainability in tourism, climate change and ecological justice

- The role of women in achieving sustainability in tourism
- Sustainability, partnerships and innovation in tourism
- Sustainability and inclusive/social entrepreneurship in tourism, hospitality and events
- Equality and sustainability in tourism, hospitality and events
- The interface between technology and sustainability in tourism, hospitality and events

Your proposal should include: a) 500 word abstract in Word format which details the research questions, research importance, method and findings and b) author(s)' biography (max. 100 words) and contact information (name, position, institution, email and mail).

If accepted, full contributions are expected to be a maximum of 5000 words including references.

Each contribution must be original and unpublished work, not submitted for publication elsewhere.
